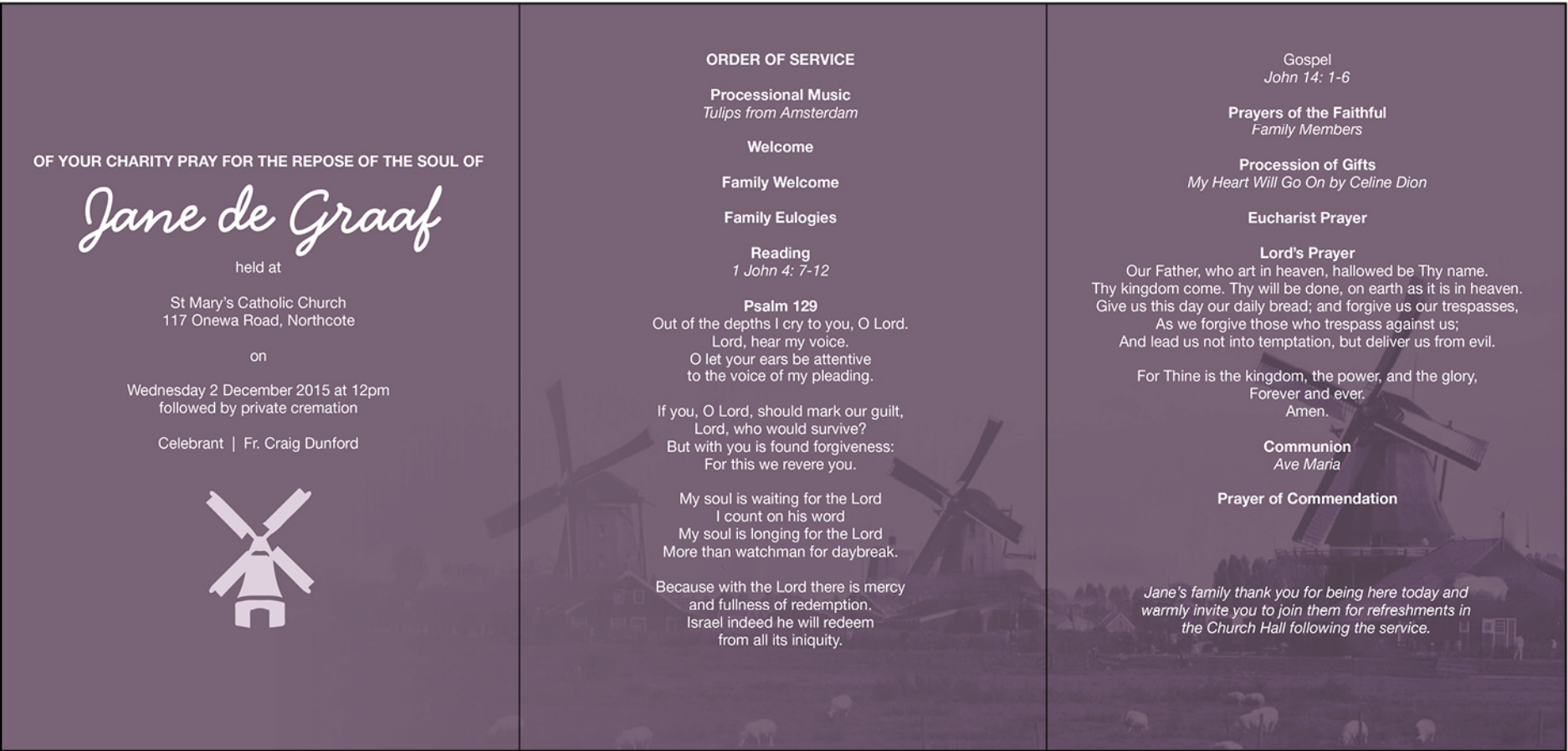
Example of service sheet design - "Trifold"

Originally from Holland, Jane loved flowers and adored the colour purple.

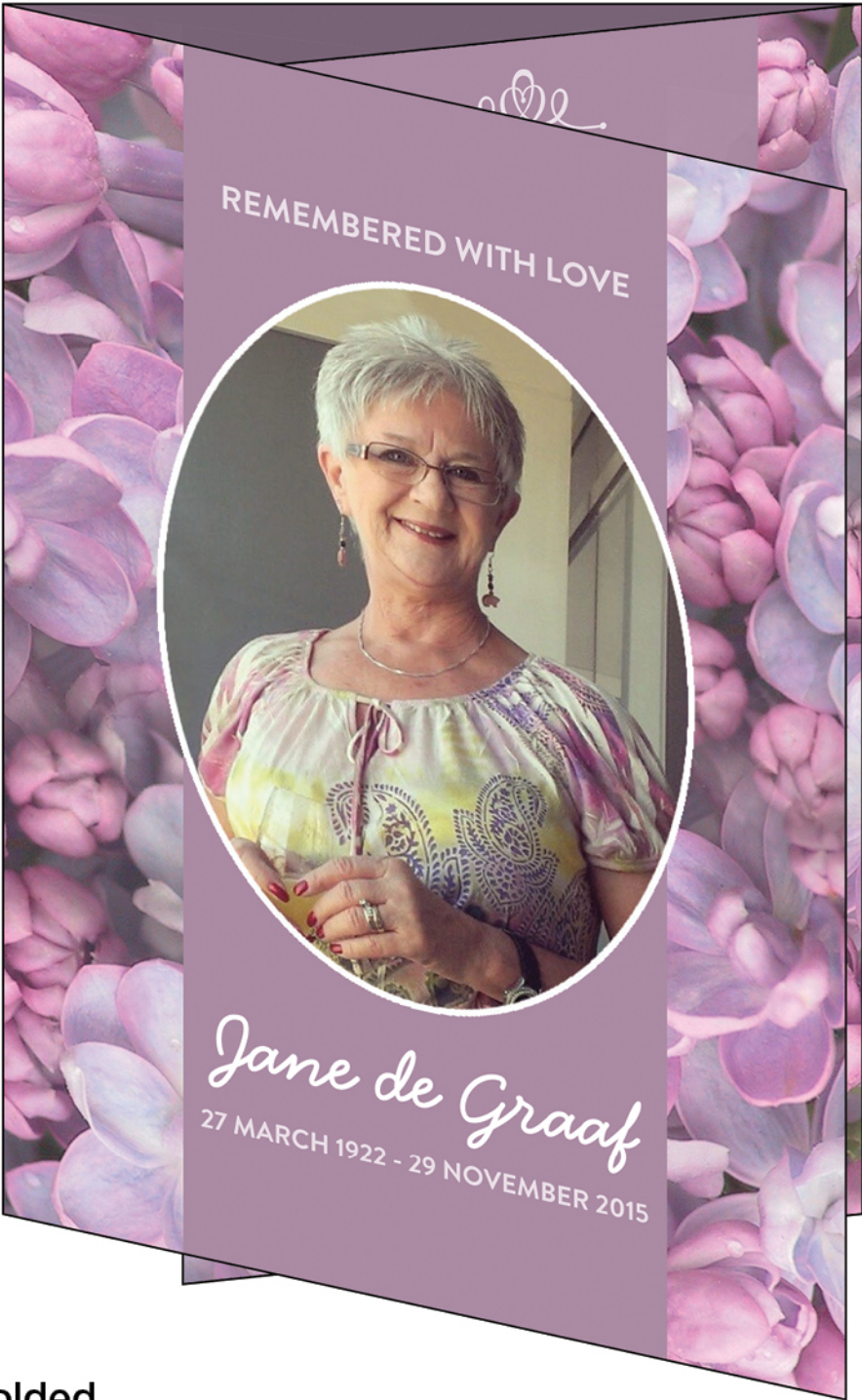

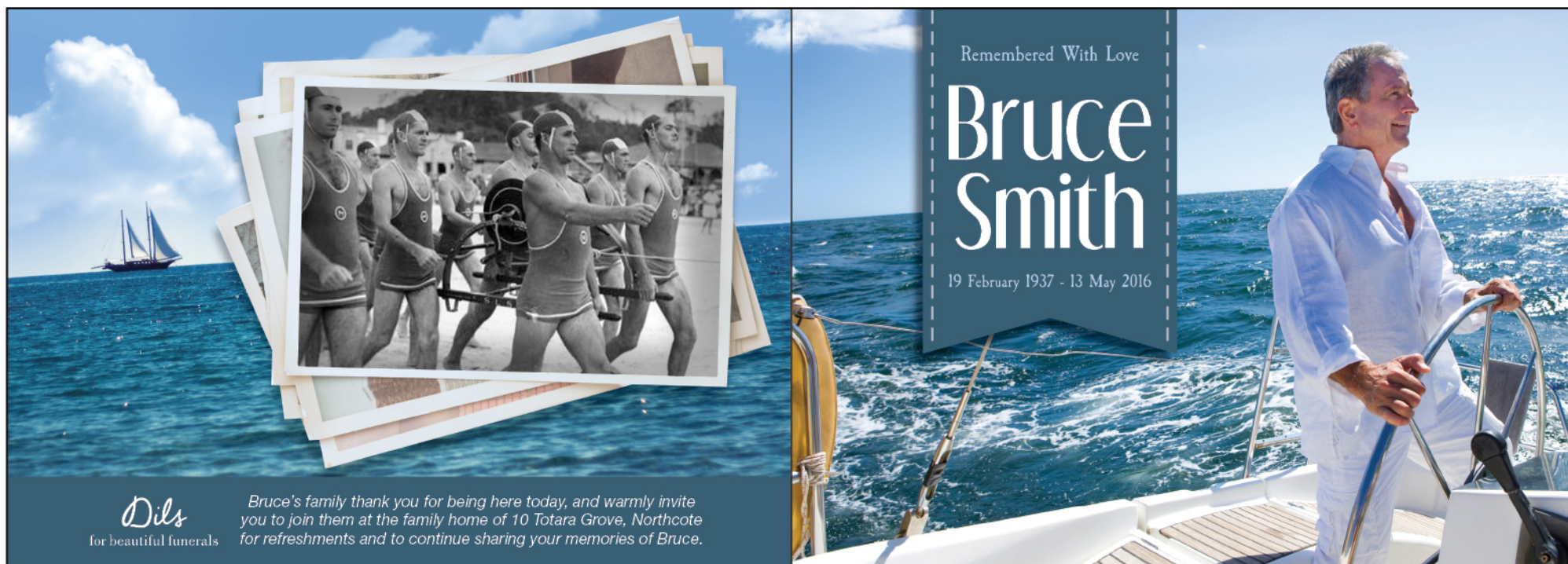

for content or photographs.

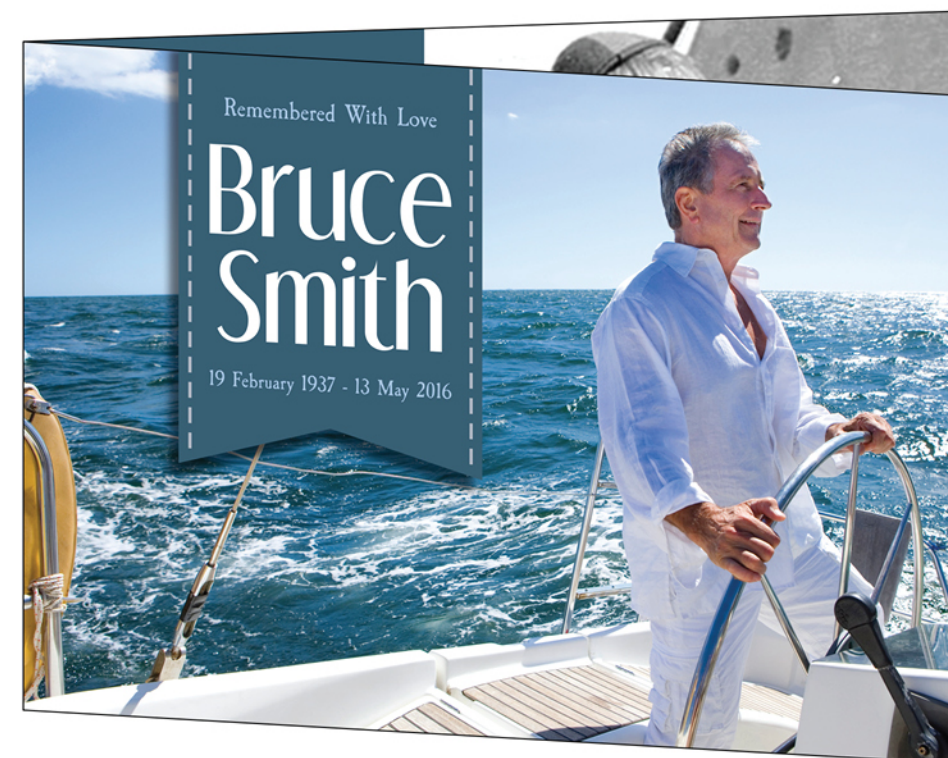

Bruce was a keen yachtsman and surf lifesaver



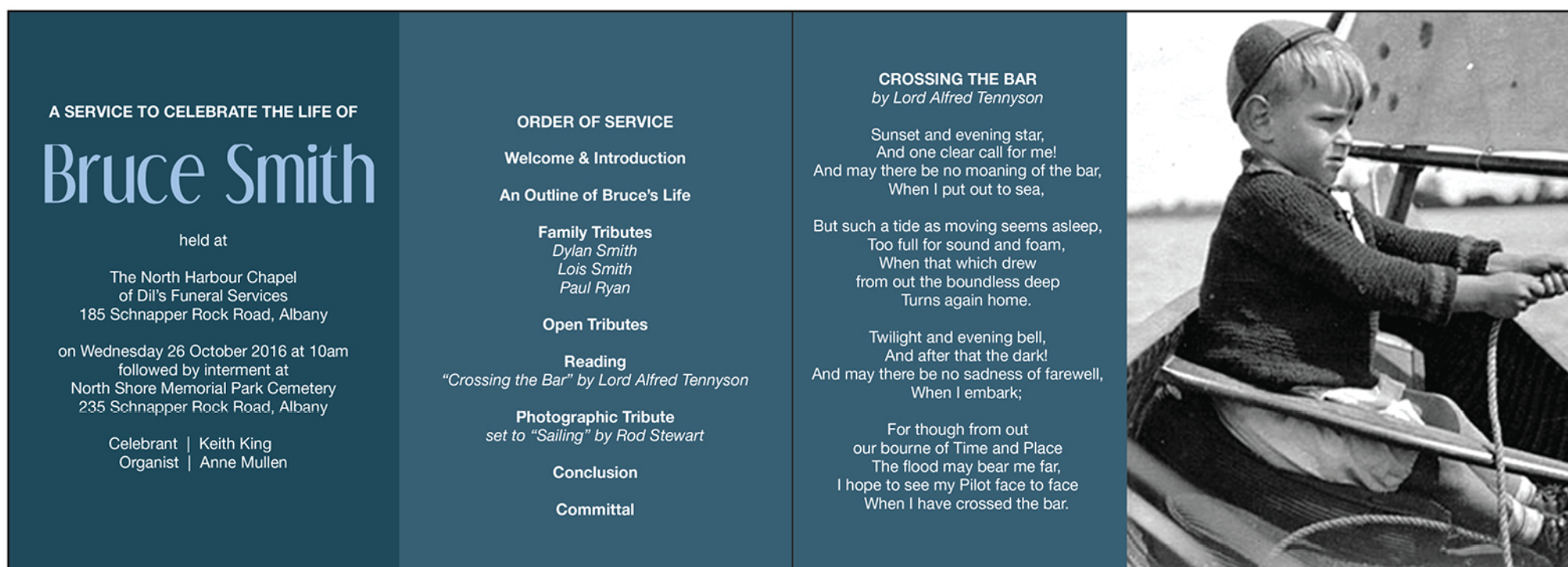

Example of service sheet design - "Three Quarter Fold"

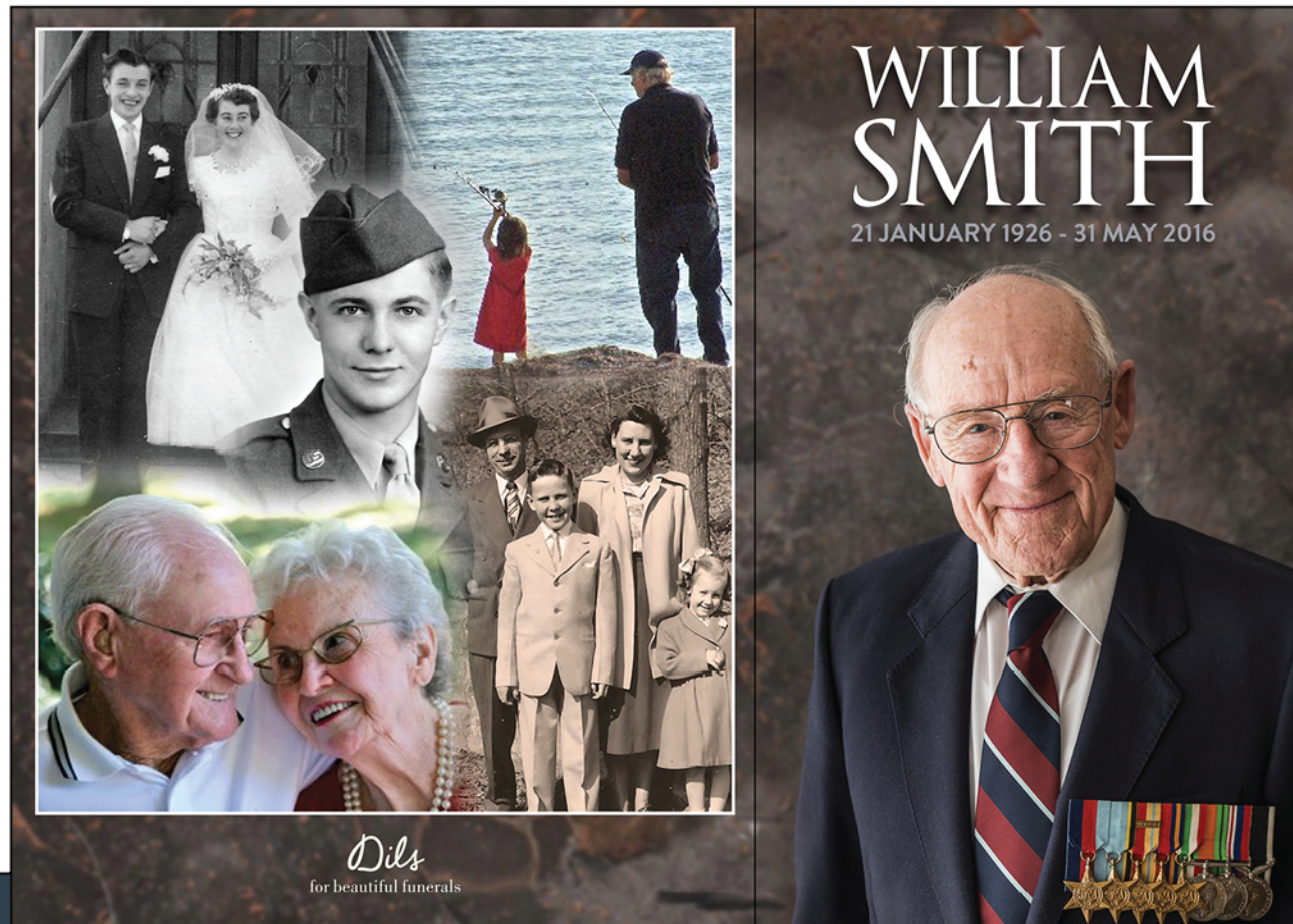
William was a WWII veteran who would proudly take part in many ANZAC dawn services.

and a grey dawn breaking.

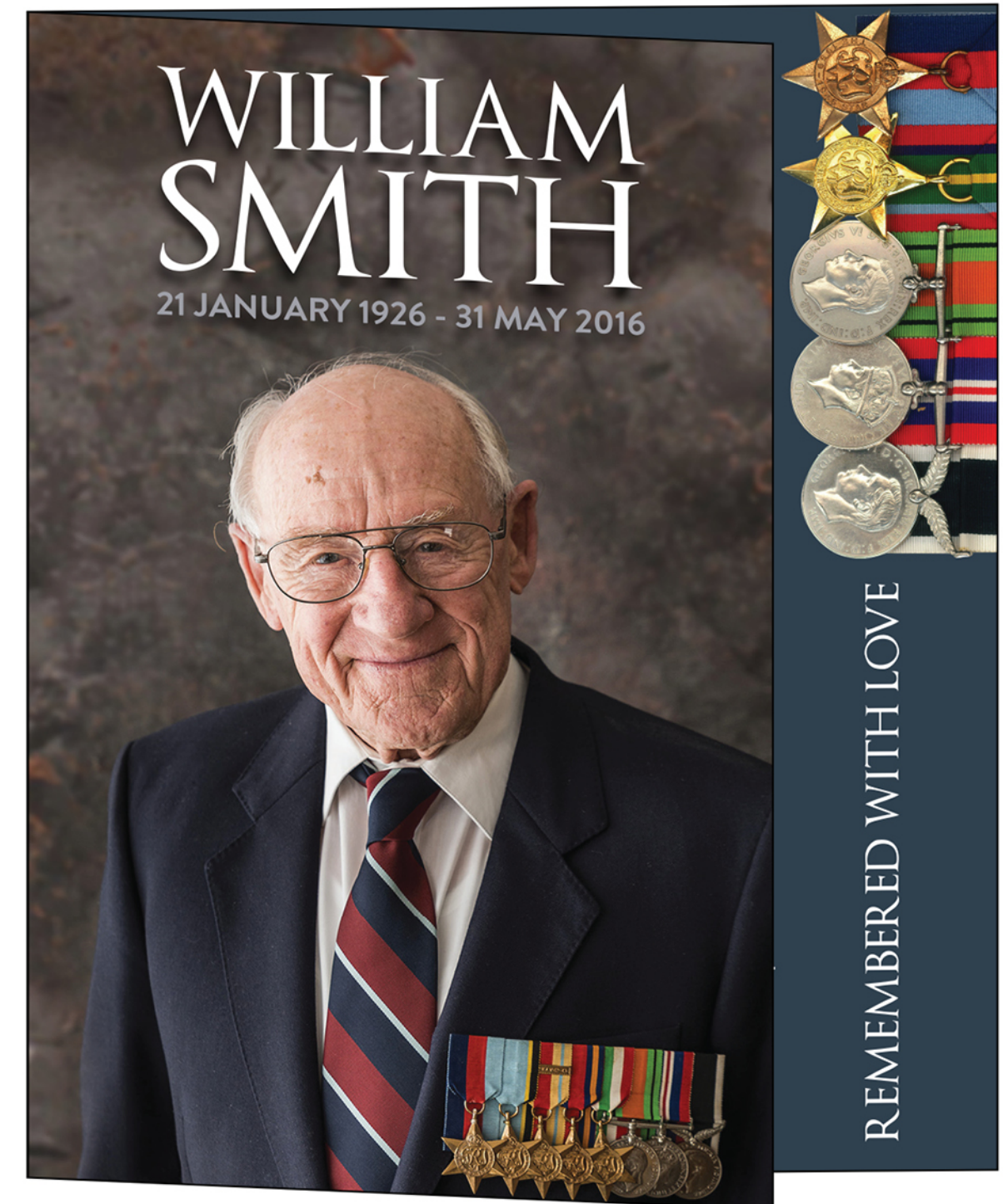
I must go down to the seas again,
